

These rules were established on 21st July 2026.

POST Luxembourg ("POST", contact details in the footer) is organising the "Naturpark Our" stamp design competition, which is free and without obligation to purchase, and valid in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.

Theme: "Imagine the Naturpark Our Stamp"

On the occasion of the "Naturparkfest", taking place on Sunday, 2 August 2026, in Hosingen, POST invites children to imagine the "Naturpark Our" stamp! Through this free competition, everyone can imagine and draw their own stamp inspired by the "Naturpark Our": wildlife, flora, landscapes, or unlimited creativity... Get your pencils ready, set, draw!

Competition Rules

Participation in the competition implies full acceptance of these rules. The competition is organised by POST Luxembourg, 38 Place de la Gare, L-1616 Luxembourg.

To participate, the registration form (on the back) must be duly completed and signed by the legal guardian. Otherwise, the entry will not be considered.

Age of participants

The competition is open to children aged 4 to 12

Drawing format

Drawings must be done on an unfolded A4 sheet of paper, available at the POST stand.

Technique

Children can use colored pencils, watercolors, or any other drawing technique of their choice, with the exception of collage.

We recommend the use of colors and watercolors.

Important: Please avoid elements smaller than 2 cm to ensure accurate reproduction of the drawing on the stamp.

Submitting drawings

Drawings can be submitted directly at the POST stand during the Naturpark Our festival on August 2, 2026, or sent by mail (postmark date will be considered) no later than August 31, 2026, to the following address: POST Luxembourg, POST4Kids, 38, Place de la Gare, L-2020 Luxembourg.

Selection Criteria

In September 2026, a jury composed of two Naturpark Our staff members and three POST Luxembourg representatives will meet to select the drawings that will create a sensation... and perhaps travel far and wide as a postage stamp! The drawings will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- creativity and originality;
 - adherence to the theme;
 - artistic quality appropriate to the child's age.
- Only works meeting these criteria will be considered. The jury's decisions are final and cannot be appealed.

Prizes

The winners will be announced in October 2026.

1st Prize

- The winning stamp framed;
- Two sheets of their stamp;
- A book of their choice, adapted to the child's age and language;
- A small surprise.

2nd and 3rd Prizes

- One sheet of their stamp;
- A book of the child's choice, adapted to their age and language;
- A small surprise.

Winners will be contacted in writing and invited to an awards ceremony.

Personal data is processed by POST Luxembourg for the purposes of organising the competition and related communications. The partners act as joint data controllers. Participants have rights (access, rectification, erasure, etc.) which can be exercised by contacting privacy@post.lu. More information: www.post.lu.

Prizes cannot be exchanged, refunded, or redeemed for cash.

Participants, through their legal representative, grant POST Luxembourg the rights to use the submitted works in accordance with the terms detailed in the entry form.

POST Luxembourg reserves the right to modify, postpone, or cancel the competition in case of necessity or force majeure. These rules are governed by Luxembourg law. Any dispute will be subject to the jurisdiction of the competent courts of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.
