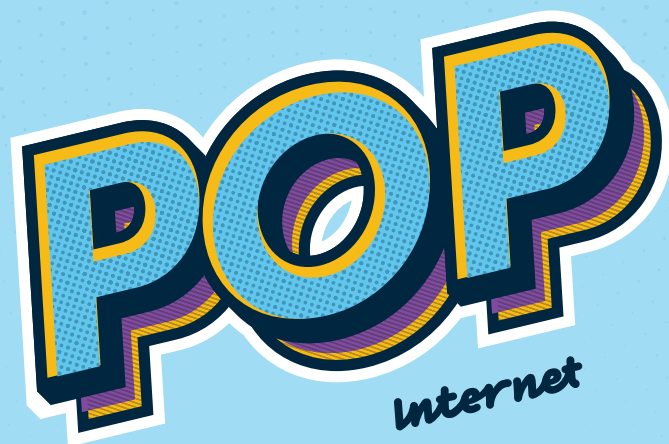

Step 1

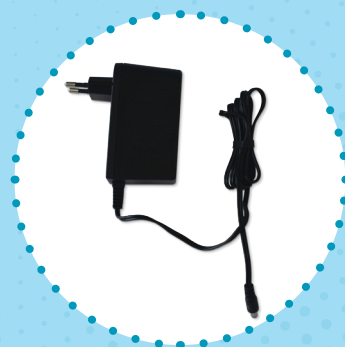
Unpack the Homebox and check that all accessories are present.

Network cable



Power cable

 **Good to know:** for the Homebox+ model, the procedure is the same.

Step 2

Plug the network cable into the POST socket.

Several connection types are possible. Choose your POST socket and follow the steps.

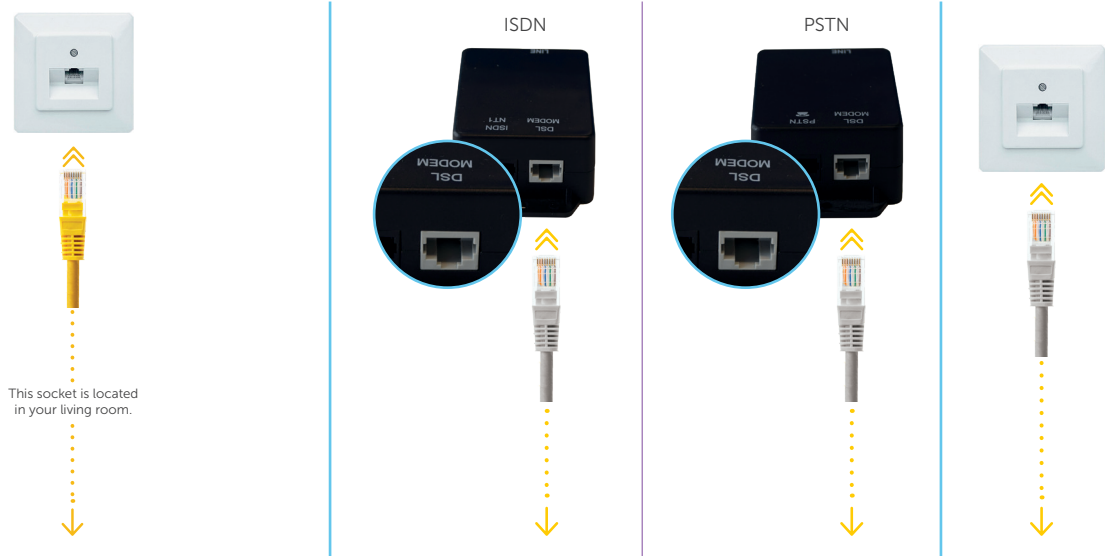

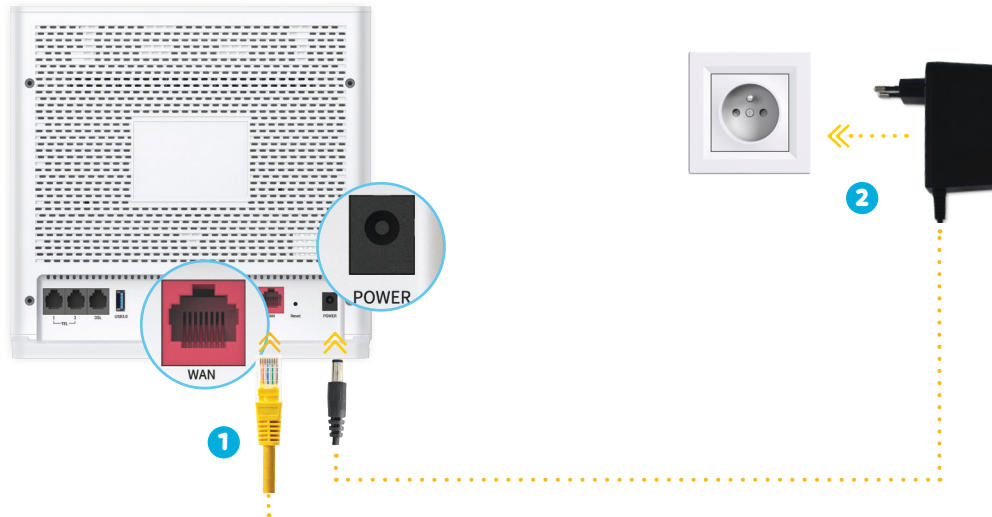

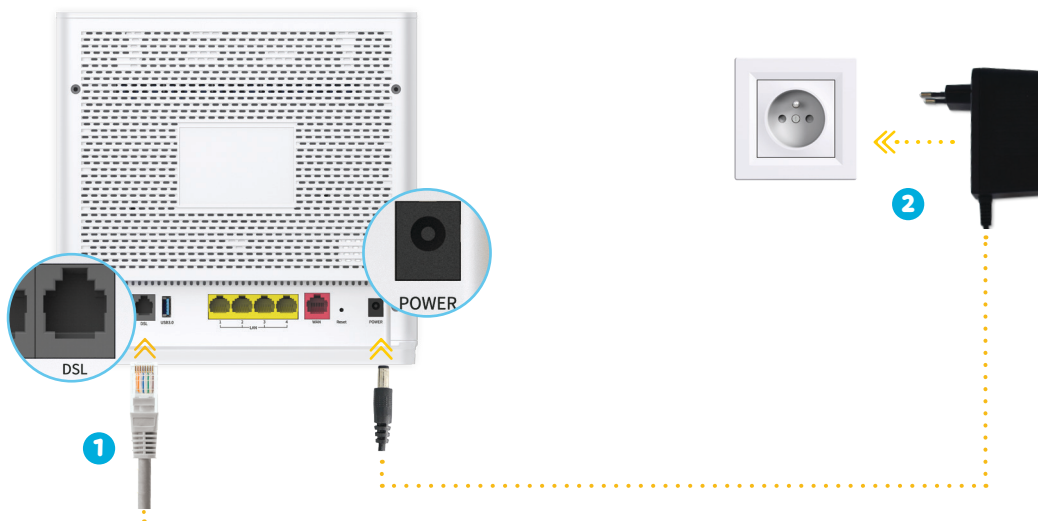
Step 3

Plug the network cable into the Homebox, then connect it to the power supply.

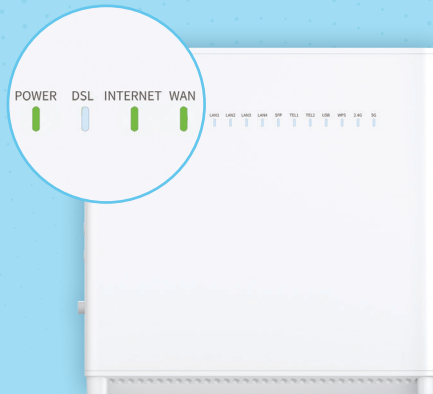
Step 4

Wait until the LEDs light up steadily.



It may take up to 15 minutes for a connection to be established and for your Homebox to be ready to operate.

During this time, the 3 LEDs (POWER, INTERNET, WAN/DSL) will blink and the device will restart several times. Once the process is complete, the 3 LEDs will remain steadily lit.



Step 5

Connect to the WiFi network.



You'll find your WiFi network name and password on the back of your Homebox.

Step 6

Connect your computer and phone(s) to the Homebox.



To do this, refer to your device's manual.
